Part I: The Importance of a Security Assessment

This systematic evaluation of physical security can be accomplished internally if your company has security personnel on staff with the appropriate expertise. If this isn't the case, an external expert should be contacted to provide a thorough assessment and recommendations. Now more than ever, keeping your people, assets and operations safe is mission critical; and a physical security assessment is a proactive and responsible step toward accomplishing this goal.
